Gentlemen:

I hand you, herewith, certification by the Secretary of State of your district's official organization, together with your appointments, duly certified to by the Secretary of State and myself as Chairman of the State Soil Conservation Committee.

I wish to congratulate the District on its successful completion of the organization and you individually on your appointment and your efforts to found and help to bring about this organization. You will note that this certification of the Honorable Harry M. Moore, Secretary of State, and your appointments are combined as one instrument for the files of the District and they are being sent to the member who resides at the town designated as the District office or headquarters.

The law provides that, within thirty days after the issuance of this certificate, petitions may be prepared and circulated for the election of three permanent supervisors and also that the temporary supervisors are eligible to participate in the coming election. Forms of petitions, ballots and other necessary materials for the election are being prepared and will be mailed to you in due time, together with full instructions for the conduct of the election.

As chairman of the State Committee, I will look to the temporary supervisors in cooperation with the County Agents, if you wish to enlist their services, in the conduct of the coming elections. I am sure that the Federal Soil Conservation offices will also cooperate with us in the printing of ballots, etc., as they did previously.
